## Respect and Kindness

- Treat everyone with respect, kindness, and courtesy. This makes you a shining star!



## Punctuality and Commitment

- Be on time so that you do not feel anxious at the start of your event. An early start keeps you calm and confident!

## Follow Instructions

- It is important to listen and follow the rules and regulations given so that you can participate actively and you will not miss out on the fun!

## Safety Guidelines

- Prioritise your safety and the safety of your friends.
- Wear appropriate protective gear if required.
- When indoors, be careful of the electrical equipment and furniture around so you do not hit them and injure yourself.

- When outdoors, stay close to the volunteers and your friends. Do not leave the premises without seeking permission of the Honeykidz coordinator.
- If you need the toilet, please inform a volunteer as they will accompany you.
- Report any safety concerns to the Honeykidz coordinator.
- Do not take photos and videos as we need to follow our privacy rules and some of us may not be comfortable at having our photos taken.
- You will be responsible for your belongings; it is encouraged not to have too much valuables with you.

- Do not use any offensive language or be disrespectful to anyone.
